Excelsior opened in brand new purpose built accommodation in September 2008. Our building, facilities and resources in all areas are outstanding. We operate three dining areas and have three specialist food teaching areas, all of extremely high specification.

The post that you are interested in is unique to our Academy. We employ our own catering team who are committed to working with our staff and pupils with regards to food and healthy eating and we have the facilities and teaching expertise to offer a wide range of courses and experiences in food. This post provides an opportunity to link the curriculum with the catering team.

The teaching and learning opportunities we offer includes preparation for external examinations as well as developing and delivering a wide range of courses and experiences that may lead to a wide range of external qualifications, or contribute to a wider enrichment / enhancement programme.
